

TALKING POINTS:

1. Genesis 1:27 NKJV: "So God created man in His own image; in the image of God He created him; male and female created He them."
2. Sylviane Agacinski, Professor of Philosophy and leader in the French Feminist movement: "The human species is divided in two and, like most other species, in two only. This division, which includes all human beings, without exception, is thus a dichotomy. In other words, every individual who is not man is woman. There is no third possibility."
3. Recently, gender theory has suggested that there is a spectrum of genders and some understand themselves at various points along this spectrum. This gender theory has been accepted by some today as though some new scientific discovery has revealed this. No such discovery has been made. This suggestion or idea is based purely on ideology. There is no reliable science that indicates there are any more than two genders.
4. Gender theorists believe that being a boy or girl doesn't happen naturally but rather "constructed" by our culture to act either male or female and nothing else. However, neurological, anthropological and psychological research tells us that there is a universal human male and female nature. There are distinct male and female brains identified through brain scans, just as there are male and female hormones. There is clear and universal male and female nature and it is readily recognized from culture to culture.
5. Gender theory simply capriciously states that sexuality and gender are different. But this pronouncement is based solely on ideology, not objective science. It's obvious that the two sexes live out their particular sex in various ways, but governments, lawmakers and especially school boards should not be influenced and motivated by misinformed emotionally manipulative efforts to lay aside common sense and empirical scientific truth.
